Viña Mayu Pedro Ximenez D.O Elqui Valley	2013	USA	The Wine Advocate <small>The 2013 Pedro Ximenez is from very old vineyards in parra style on decomposed granite, quartz-rich soils, and might well be the highest vineyard in Chile. The place has a special brightness – I'm talking about the quality of the light from the high altitude – that brings the aromas out. This is much more expressive than your average Pedro Ximenez, with aromas of white flowers, fennel and some spiciness, very dry, with high acidity thanks to the altitude as well as tension and minerality. If you like the fresh, austere style, this is a real steal. A good alternative to Sauvignon for seafood. Drink now-2016.</small>	91/100 
Viña Mayu Sauvignon Blanc D.O Elqui Valley	2013	USA	The Wine Advocate <small>The 2013 Sauvignon Blanc is from a vineyard where there's an astrological observatory and the wine is both stony and restrained, with piercing herbal aromas and a mineral feeling. The palate is clean and delineated, with moderate acidity and good freshness. A nice Sauvignon at a very good price. Impressive. Drink now.</small>	89/100 
Viña Mayu Carmenere-Syrah D.O Elqui Valley	2013	USA	The Wine Advocate <small>The 2013 Carmenere-Syrah is an unusual blend, where the Syrah is grown on a very chalky slope at high altitude, and the Carmenere grows on gravel soils. The wine aged in used oak, but the wood is imperceptible, adding hints of spices, with the herbal side of the Carmenere complementing the richness of the Syrah. It has some peppery notes, all of it in a fresh and delineated style that is elegant, quite straightforward and very drinkable. A bargain red for the table. Drink now-2018.</small>	90/100
